by incorporating the five early literacy practices integral to raising a reader:

talking reading playing
writing singing

Story Time familiarizes children with important early concepts such as colors, numbers, opposites, time, five senses, spatial relationships (over/under, on top of, etc.,) feelings, and much, much more.
